ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

***It is the responsibility of the parent of students entering Hernando County public schools to present the following at the time of registration.

Registration information must be complete, partial registrations will **not** be accepted.

Students transferring from out of state or new Kindergarten students must have the following: Must provide at time of enrollment:

- A Current Physical (dated within 12 months of enrollment)
- Immunization Record on State of Florida 680 form
- Birth Certificate with State Seal
- Recent Grades and/or Report Card
- Recent Test Scores
- Proof of In-Zone Residency (e.g. Utility bill, Mortgage, Lease—not driver's license) Should fill out the following forms:
 - Entire enrollment packet

Students transferring from another county within the State of Florida:

Must provide at time of enrollment:

- Immunization Record on State of Florida 680 form
- Current Physical (proof of physical from previous school)
- Birth Certificate with State Seal
- Recent Grades and/or Report Card
- Recent Test Scores
- Proof of In-Zone Residency (e.g. Utility bill, Mortgage, Lease-not driver's license) Should fill out the following forms:
 - Entire enrollment packet

Students transferring from another Hernando County School:

At time of enrollment:

- Request all records to be sent from the other school
- Recent Grades and/or Report Card
- **Recent Test Scores**
- Proof of In-Zone Residency (e.g. Utility bill, Mortgage, Lease—not driver's license)
 Should fill out the following forms:

 Student Emergency Information & registration forms

 - Release of Student Information from previous school

UNIFORM POLICY

School uniforms are mandatory for J.D. Floyd Elementary Students

- Navy, Black, or Khaki (tan) pants, shorts, skirts or jumpers
- Solid color polo shirts, plain or with Floyd Logo
- No large logos, emblems, zippers, or laces on shirts
- Navy or white sweaters & sweatshirts allowed
- Natural hair coloring
- No sweat pants, jeans, denim, leggings, spandex, stretch or nylon material.
- No hats or sunglasses
- School bags on wheels only permitted for grades 4 and up
- For safety reasons no open toed shoes, sandals, flip flops, heels, or platforms
- Outerwear winter jackets may be any color
