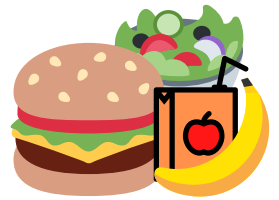


STUDENT LUNCH NUMBERS

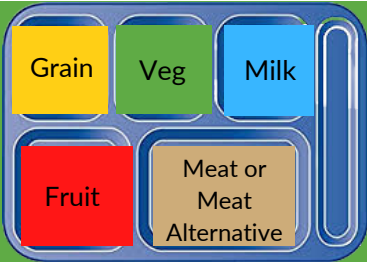
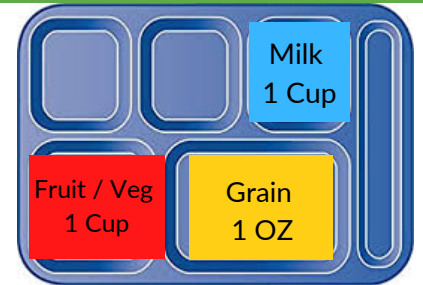
TITAN SCHOOL SOLUTIONS

NO COST BREAKFAST

Breakfast: Choose at least 3 items, 1 item must be a fruit or vegetable. Students may take a maximum of 2 fruit or vegetables, 1 entrée and 1 milk.



NO COST LUNCH

Lunch: Choose at least 3 components, 1 component must be a fruit or vegetable. Choose a minimum of 3 components to avoid being charged a la carte pricing. Students may take a maximum of 2 servings of fruit, 2 servings of vegetables, an entrée and a milk.
