2. Schedule parent-teacher conferences as needed to work together to solve problems.
3. Notify parents when there is a concern about academic progress or classroom behavior.
4. Post grades on Edline on a weekly basis.
5. Provide a midterm progress report to keep parents informed about student progress and school-wide events.
6. Notify parents by automated calls when students are absent.

## Students in the Classroom and at Home


1. Attend school every day.
