HERNANDO COUNTY SCHOOLS INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS RIDING BUSES

- Respect the driver and follow instructions. 1.
- Remain seated; head and arms inside bus and keep your hands to yourself. 2.
- 3. Keep door and aisle clear of obstacles, no pets, glass or large items including large band instruments.
- Do not throw anything on the bus or out of the window at anytime. 4.
- Be absolutely quiet when the dome lights are on. 5.
- Do not eat, drink or chew gum on the bus. Use of tobacco products is prohibited. 6.
- Quiet conversations only. 7.
- Use of profane or obscene language and gestures are prohibited. 8.
- After waiting for the driver's signal, cross the road in front of the bus. 9.
- A permission slip signed by the principal or designee is required for riding another bus or 10. getting off at a different stop.
- Pre-K through 2nd grade students MUST be met at the afternoon bus stop by an adult or they 11. will be returned to school.
