

Topic: Plan to Rezone Winding Waters

1. Will there be any changes to high school zones?

No. Neither proposal will create changes to high school attendance boundaries.

2. Will WWK8 be open as a School Choice option?

No. Due to capacity, WWK8 will not be an option for school choice. While the district will still run a lottery there will be no offers made for WWK8.

Lottery: The lottery will begin in March. Families will be notified of the results via email and/or text through School Mint on March 10th. The school district will maintain a waitlist for one year.

3. If my current 7th grader attends WWK8 under School Choice, will they have to move to a different school for 8th grade?

No. Per Florida law, **IF** the next school year is the highest grade level at that school, students enrolled through school choice may remain at the school for the next school year. Current 7th graders, enrolled at WWK8, through **school choice**, may remain at WWK8 for 8th grade.

4. Will this rezone affect my child's options for VPK?

Until the Board makes the final rezoning decision, it is difficult to know the impact to current VPK zones.

5. When will the final decision be made?

The school board will vote on March 28, 2023 during the 6 PM meeting.
