- Move each wheelchair into its place on the bus and properly secure the wheelchair into place
- Secure all seat belts, car seats and wheelchair tie-downs
- Account for all students
- Be familiar with characteristics of students assigned to bus routes
- Under the direction of the bus operator, assist in controlling student behavior on the bus
- Assist operator in all emergency situations in a calm and orderly manner
- Become familiar with the responsibilities of the bus operator, including knowledge of radio procedures and the route the bus takes daily
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Safety & Training Specialist and/or designee
