Accessories

- Jewelry should be worn in such a way that does not present a safety or health hazard. NO spiked jewelry or accessories are acceptable.
- Wallet chains and dog chains are not acceptable.
- Bandanas are not allowed to be worn in any fashion (head, belt, etc.).
- Hats and sunglasses are ONLY to be worn outside and with the permission of a staff member.
- Hoods from any article of clothing or ear buds <u>may not be</u> <u>worn inside the building</u>.
- Apparel, jewelry, tattoo, markings, accessories, or manner of grooming that denotes membership in a gang, advocates drugs, tobacco products, alcohol, violence, and/or sexual innuendo is NOT acceptable.

The WWK-8 dress code policy is in addition to the District dress code. Please see p.43 of the Hernando County Student Code of Conduct.

Consequences

- First Offense: A student shall be given a warning and administration or their designee shall call the student's parent/guardian to bring a change of clothes.
- Second Offense: The student is ineligible to participate in any extracurricular activity for a period of time not to exceed five (5) days, may lose a privilege, and administration or their designee shall call or meet with the student's parent/guardian and ask them to bring a change of clothes.
- Third or Subsequent Offense:
 A student shall receive an inschool suspension for a period not to exceed three (3) days, is ineligible to participate in any extracurricular activity for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, and may lose additional privileges. Administration shall call the student's parent or guardian to bring a change of clothes and send a letter re: the ISS and ineligibility.

Administration will have final discretion on ALL dress code violations.

Appropriate Tops and Jackets

- Tops do not have to be tucked in, but must be long enough so that when hands are raised above the head or when bending over no skin is visible.
- Blouses with a neckline that dips below the line formed between the right and left armpit are not acceptable.
- <u>NO</u> spaghetti straps, tank tops, muscle shirts, or any seethrough material, halter/strapless top are acceptable.



Appropriate Bottoms

- Must be fingertip length
- Bottoms that have any type of rip or hole <u>must ensure the rip</u> or hole is at the knee or lower.
- All bottoms must be secured at the waist. Undergarments must not be exposed.
- Pajamas/onesies are <u>not</u> acceptable.
- Leggings, spandex, or yoga
 pants <u>must</u> be worn with a skirt,
 dress, or shirt of a <u>mid-thigh</u>
 length. Any shirt worn with
 leggings or spandex pants <u>must</u>
 be the length of the mid-thigh.
