

## Technology in K-12 Public Schools and Use of Cell Phones in School



Summary: House Bill 379 requires:

- school districts prohibit the use of wireless communication devices (WCD) in the Student Code of Conduct
- teachers designate an area for wireless communications devices during instructional time.
- public schools to provide instruction on the social, emotional, and physical effects of social media, etc.

What does this mean for my student? In Hernando Schools, teachers will direct students to place their cell phones in a designated area during instructional time unless the devices are used for educational purposes and under the supervision of the teacher. In HCSD, "designated area" is typically the students backpack.

What do I need to do? Parents may wish to familiarize themselves with the new law and talk with your child's teacher to better understand classroom rules regarding cell phones.

Remember - Focused instructional time is limited each day and students who are distracted by their phones will miss important directions, conversations and lessons.
